I have been a priest for 35 years and this is my fifth pastoral assignment, serving as pastor at St. Jude since 2002. From the first time I drove upon the property in September, 2002, I could tell this is a parish with people truly invested in themselves and their mission. From the early hours of the morning, beginning with 5:30 a.m. exercise opportunities, to

late nights of meetings, gatherings and parish functions, the parking lot is rarely empty and the lights never dim. Our theme for our 50th Anniversary that we celebrated in 2009 was "Looking back with Pride…and Forward with Hope." We continue to do this.

Here is a little information about us. St. Jude is one of the larger parishes in the archdiocese with over 5,000 active members and a school with 509 children. We reside on a campus of nearly 12 acres which includes our Church, parish center, school and newly remodeled youth center. We operate on a current budget of \$4,126,527 and employ 86 paid staff members and, of course, benefit from the work of hundreds upon hundreds of our dedicated volunteers.

The warmth, openness, willingness to forgive and generosity of so many in giving, volunteering and supporting those in need have shown me that St. Jude is truly founded on the principles of what a parish is called to be. I feel gifted to be a part of this community and I hope you will be able to visit us in near future for you to see what a treasure we are to the Archdiocese of Indianapolis.



Religious Education

At St. Jude, we believe the faith development of a child is a lifelong journey shared between families and the parish community. Since parents are the primary educators of their children, our Religious Education program seeks to support parents in this lifelong journey of faith formation by providing programs which instruct in scripture, doctrine, prayer and worship. We also assist in preparing children for their Sacraments; all in the hopes of nurturing personal and spiritual growth. Currently, 145 children are enrolled in our first through eighth-grade Religious Education program; 85 attend Children's Liturgy of the Word, 45 attend Sunday preschool, 150 enjoy Vacation Bible School and 80 children are preparing for sacraments.







Young Adults

Through a culture of hospitality, we desire to *invite* people into community and fellowship with one another, *invest* in each other through authentic relationships, and *ignite* a fire in their hearts to live intentionally for Christ and evangelize our world. 




Young At Heart

Did you know that having a variety of positive social supports can contribute to psychological and physical health? In some studies, successful aging is positively related to socializing with neighbors, religious participation and volunteering. We meet monthly, usually on the second Friday of the month at 11:00 am in the Parish Center Assembly Room. Youth Ministry

St. Jude's Youth Ministry is based on the Life Teen program that leads teens closer to Christ through a weekly youth-centered Mass Sunday at Noon, Sunday evening Youth Group for high school students, monthly gatherings for 5th grade students and weekly get-togethers for 6th/7th/8th grade students.

More than 300 youth are served through our programs. These fun-filled, high energy activities reach our youth spiritually, emotionally, and socially. Our youth program also encompasses sacramental preparation for Confirmation,

scouting programs and CYO.
